### Selection Criteria

1. results in Year 12 as projected by the Principal of each nominating School, as follows:
  - overall: at least HA in 5 subjects
  - for BE: at least HA in Maths B and at least HA in Physics or Chemistry
  - for BInfTech: at least HA in Maths B
2. recommendation by the Principal as to quality of the student's performance, character and suitability for university study
3. evident strong interest in engineering and/or information technology studies through demonstrated participation in school, extracurricular and community activities related to the nominated degree program.
4. excellent communication, interpersonal skills and demonstrated potential for leadership.

### Application to QTAC Essential

In addition to nomination for this direct entry scheme, students will need to apply through QTAC as normal and to nominate the relevant UQ degree (BE, BInfTech) as a preference.

### Interviews

Nominees may be required to present for interview by UQ and Education Queensland representatives. Telephone interviews may be arranged for non-metropolitan nominees.

### Results

After the selection committee has reached conclusions, UQ will communicate the university's commitment of a place in the appropriate degree to the successful students and also advise unsuccessful students. UQ Admissions will ensure that successful students' matching applications through QTAC will be identified and result in a formal offer of places at UQ. Up to 20 direct entry places will be offered for 2009.

### Procedures

1. Nominations for Direct Entry are being advertised to the Gateway schools during Terms 2 & 3.
2. Individual schools will select students according to selection criteria 1 and 2 above.
3. Schools will submit nominations to the Education Queensland's Head of Department Aerospace Industries (HODAI) Fax (07) 3637 0100, up to a maximum of three students per school.

### Deadlines

Principals of Gateway Schools should submit nominations to the HODAI by the second-last week of school term 3 (**12 September 2008**). Outcomes will be communicated to applicants and schools early in term 4.
