

## Scholarships:

UQ invites eligible HCMUT students to apply for scholarships valued from \$11 050 to \$23 000 per year. A limited number of scholarships are awarded based on academic excellence to students applying for the Bachelor of Engineering or Bachelor of Information Technology.

Conditions: The scholarships cover 50 – 100% of the tuition fee for the duration of a standard undergraduate program. The scholarships are available for international students who have completed postsecondary studies in Vietnam and are eligible for credit articulation. The successful applicant must be classed as an international student in Australia (Australian permanent residents and Australian citizens are not eligible).

Scholarship applications must be received at UQ by:

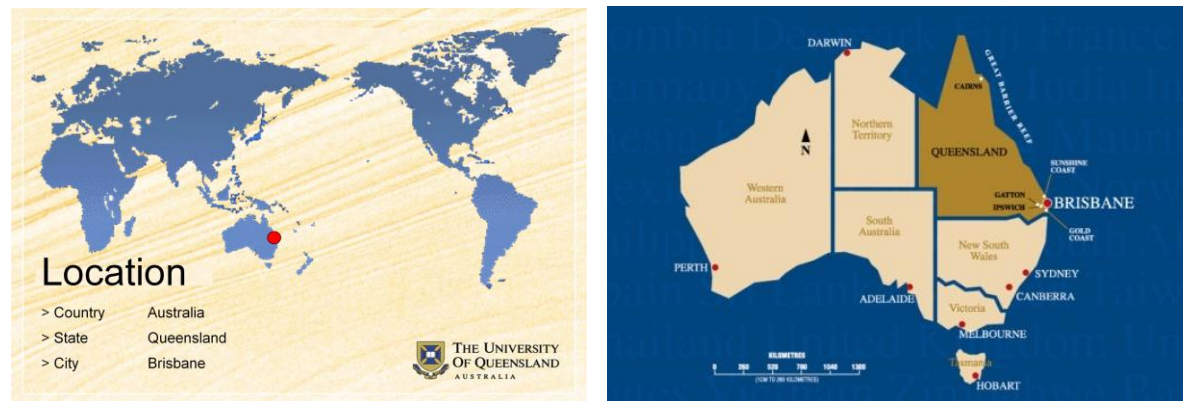
- 31 October to commence in Semester 1 (February) or
- 31 May to commence in Semester 2 (July)

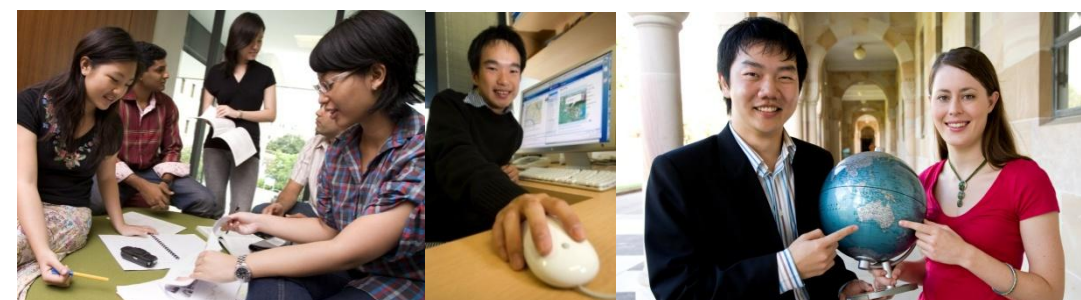

### UQ entry requirements & procedures:

Academic:

- Achieve a minimum overall GPA of 5.8 on the 10 point scale for all courses completed at HCMUT prior to admission to UQ

English Language:

- an IELTS score of 6.5 overall with an Individual Writing Band score of 6.0; or
- a TOEFL score of 570 overall with a Test of Written English score of 5; or
- a computerised TOEFL score of 237 with an essay rating of 4.5

After completing at least two semesters study at HCMUT, make an application through the HCMUT Office of International Study Programs.

### UQ Fees & Costs:

- tuition for Bachelor of Engineering \$AU25, 530 per year
- tuition for Bachelor of Information Technology \$AU25, 330 per year
